CONNOR'S COLLEEN rushed to duel down the backside, went clear into the lane, won ridden out. DEVIL OF A BAG well placed throughout, saved ground, put to an all out drive top of the lane, failed to threaten, just held the place position. SHE'S SO COLD raced evenly and between foes, rallied mid track top of the lane, closed willingly. CLOUDY DIA broke alertly, was out rushed for the lead, pressed and chased from mid turn, came up short from mid stretch. REDS REVENGE raced evenly while off the rail, roused from the quarter pole, angled inside top of the stretch, was under left handed stick but failed to rally. MI' DESERAI had no speed, went very wide down the backside, managed a brief gain near the quarter pole, proved no factor. CLEVER SIS raced evenly and was five wide throughout, asked for more, gave no response and tired in the drive. MINDY'S TIME broke late, was never involved. LADY PICASSO raced evenly early, dropped off mid turn, vanned off.
