Footnotes

WE ALL DREAM saved ground early angling out near the quarter pole, rallied to even terms four deep in upper stretch edging away under a drive. AZSTOR slow early advanced to contention in upper stretch, swung out six wide near the eighth pole came on for place. AFTERNOON SNOOZE came away alertly, dueled between horses through the turn, extended in upper stretch would weaken while bumping with WILD ALEX late. WILD ALEX broke sharply pressuring the pace three wide through the turn, dueling abreast AFTERNOON SNOOZE in upper stretch would weaken as the pair bumped late. SEATTLE EXPRESSO was sent hard pressing on the inside of rivals through the turn, began to waver in upper stretch fading with little left. CAT AND CUSTARD gave hard pursuit through the turn then weakened under a drive. FOUR ONE ONE was never involved. WABASH RIVER showed early speed while saving ground, gave way inside the eighth pole. EGALITARIAN was squeezed and forced to check at the break. FRIENDLY TOWNSHIP folding up early was eased to the wire.
