CARDINAL RIDGE stumbled badly leaving the gate, rushed to recover advanced through the turn chasing five deep in upper stretch, no match for the winner kept on to save place. WE WUZ ROBBED slow early split horses along the inside in upper stretch coming on to finish well. VICTORIOUS JET was hustled along through the turn, made no headway down the stretch finishing evenly. WHERESTHELIMIT gave hard pursuit through the turn then weakened in upper stretch. QUEENS TONY chased through the turn, wore out in upper stretch. BRAVE REWARD flashed early speed then retreated along the rail. QUICK CARNAGE had brief foot then stopped abruptly on the turn.
