FILLAZZEN well placed sat off CONQUISTADOR GAL through the far turn angling abreast in the three path upper stretch, would extend to go by late. CONSOLIDATOR GAL broke alert setting a soft pace while saving ground to upper stretch, digging in near the rail became leg weary ceding the issue late. SOUL FIRE stalked the pace through the backside dropping off the leaders on the far turn, moved evenly in the four path down the lane holding the others safe. MISS SWEET N SOUR dropped back early varying little through the far turn, circled out six wide in upper stretch gave a modest rally passing tired ones. COMPACT JEANNE slow early angled inside to upper stretch holding spot along the rail. CHATTY CAT close early retreated on the backside finishing up in the four path. JUST FERDIE lost ground racing five deep to the half, angled in on the far turn tiring there. KAOLIN showed little finishing along the inside. GLOSSARY had brief position before fading on the backside, labored home at mid track. PIONEERING GIRL breaking slowly was rushed between horses flattening out on the far turn.
