THE RAG MAN broke sharply, set the pace racing along the inside to upper stretch, digging in there held firm in the two path. TO THE LEFT stalked close up through the turn, angled to the four path upper stretch made no headway on the winner holding for place. BROTHER BRETT went evenly off the pace through the turn, saved ground to upper stretch, gained a bit along the inside. DURANTS AFLEET raced a step slow through the turn, held position along the rail down the stretch. GET THERE chased early then dropped off on the turn, had little left racing along the inside through the stretch. OUTERBANKS played no factor. SENOR UNO failed to respond. TIGER IN THE NORTH labored throughout.
