DANCER'S LEGACY was well rated rallying four wide on the final turn, dueled abreast CIRQUE DU SOLEIL down the stretch extending up in the final yards. CIRQUE DU SOLEIL (ARG) sent clear moved along on a soft pace to the final turn, challenged there would dig in down the stretch giving all on the inside of DANCER'S LEGACY ceding grudgingly in the last strides. KILMOGANNY raced evenly while saving ground moving to contention on the far turn, cutting the corner to upper stretch proved no match for the top pair while out finishing the rest. A. P. JEWEL went unhurried the first lap, roused on the final turn gave a modest move to upper stretch going evenly the final eighth. UNBRIDLED WISDOM stalked the pace moving to bid on the final turn, extended in upper stretch would level off late. AMAZON RUN was always outrun. PLEASANT COMPANY offered little. CHASING THE CROWN stalked the pace into the final turn folding up there.
