**Footnotes**

HYRACOTHERIUM tracked evenly through the backside, surged up on the far turn, dueled clear in the four path upper stretch, widened driving. GOLDISPRETTEY away slowly angled four wide to upper stretch, came on late for place. THREE TICKETS sent up along the inside, pressed pace through the far turn then gradually weakened the final eighth. VINTAGE DAVE stalked close up, bid to put a head in front on the far turn, weakened in the three path upper stretch. BEAR IS CONFIRMED slow early came six wide upper stretch, improved position there. CLAYVILLE slow early saved ground to upper stretch, had no surge. STREET SHOES LARRY raced second flight, wilted in the two path upper stretch. BOLD COMMAND was always outrun. THE ONE TO CHASE away alertly pressured the pace to the far turn, wore out there. MANDU GENIUS raced evenly in mid pack, flattened out after a half mile.
