Footnotes

SEACLIPSE taken in hand early, raced in the second flight running well off the rail, made a quick five wide move leaving the far turn, raced abreast foes at the quarter pole vying for the lead, cleared and opened up entering the stretch, was kept to task holding safe to the finish. IN MY BOOK unhurried early racing towards the rear, set down mid turn, swung five wide into the stretch, narrowed the gap slightly in deep stretch finishing a willing second. CIGARILLO raced up close from the start, bid in tandem mid turn vying for the lead running between foes, proved no match form upper stretch but held well saving third place. GLOUCESTER BAY was never far off the pace running along the rail, almost drew even at the three eighths pole in a five way battle, could not keep pace top of the lane and tired late besting rest. STALL JACK rated early racing in the second flight, bid four wide racing between rivals on the turn, flattened out mid stretch and was no late factor. ROYAL CHAPEL raced up close traveling three wide to the half, vied mid turn, was all done top of the lane weakening in the drive. TOUGH GRIND lagged for six furlongs, swung out six wide entering the stretch, failed to menace. NORTHERN RANSOM raced in good tracking position running along the rail down the backside, roused to no avail on the bend, lacked response. LITTLE BRUISER sent early setting a pressured pace along the rail, battled gamely to the quarter pole, gave way top of the stretch, used up.
