TURNPIKE TOMMY raced four wide abreast foes going into the first turn, cleared entering the backside and angled towards the rail, maintained a slight edge throughout, lost the lead to DONT TELL KITTEN in upper stretch, came again under strong urging inside the eighth pole, put a head in front late and was fully extended to prevail in a very determined effort. ROMAN SUR unhurried and trailed to the far turn running along the rail, angled out on the bend, came widest into the stretch racing six wide, surged in deep stretch to just miss in a game effort. IMITATION OF LIFE tracked the pace to the far turn, bid three wide to vie for the lead at the quarter pole, fought hard throughout the stretch run but was outgamed late missing in a hard effort. DONT TELL KITTEN stalked early on, bid in tandem mid turn, out ahead in front mid stretch, was outfinished late missing a minor award. REEL PRIME stalked down the backstretch racing in the three path, dueled on the far turn running between foes, tired inside the eighth pole. BONNISTAR tracked the pace to the half running four wide, put to a drive on the bend giving chase, lacked kick and weakened in the drive. LOST APTITUDE raced evenly traveling five to six wide down the backside, roused far turn, offered little never threatening.
