KENYAFLY stalked down the backside racing three wide, vied for the lead mid turn, drew off form mid stretch, widened to the wire under steady urging. PYRRHIC SECRET unhurried leaving the gate, moved off the rail entering the backside, rushed a middle move at the half, vied mid turn racing three to four wide, proved no match from mid stretch while holding second place. POLITE COMPANY rated early traveling off the rail, launched rally coming five wide into the stretch, was under strong left handed stick, surged late winning the battle for third place. FILLAZZENE taken in hand in the early going, gained momentum from the quarter pole, angled towards the inside mid stretch, finished willingly just missing third place. LE BEE showed good speed pressing for the lead, moved in tandem going into the far turn, vied in a thee way duel mid turn running along the inside, could not keep pace entering the stretch dropping off a bit, angled to mid track giving chase, tired late missing a minor award. PAWN SHOP QUEEN rated and trailed at the half running along the rail, passed a couple of weary foes mildly improving placing but never factored. WHAT SAY YOU settled in mid pack, angled inside top of the lane, failed to factor. DANCING TIGER set a pressured pace racing along the rail to the half, stopped leaving the quarter pole and was eased in upper stretch while finishing the course.
