Footnotes

SOARING CLEAR rushed into the first turn, dueled with PULPIT'S JET to the half, put that rival away mid turn and then was threatened by SHOW ME THE CASH at the quarter pole, responded nicely to urging top of the stretch to quickly draw off, won easily being ridden out. SHOW ME THE CASH stalked throughout running four wide to the half, gained mid turn to loom off the winner at the quarter pole, was turned away mid stretch and then was fully extended to save the place position at the wire. SCRIMPY unhurried and raced wide down the backstretch, mounted strong rally leaving the quarter pole, finished gamely to just miss second place but never menaced the winner. AWAY I GO settled towards the rear, roused at the quarter pole and angled four wide top of the stretch, bid between foes in the lane, closed belatedly missing a minor award. RUM CUSTOMER well placed tracking the pace, angled five wide under a stiff drive top of the lane, failed to respond lacking rally. LAIRD'S QUEST rated and raced five wide to the half, gained on the bend and threatened the winner at the quarter pole, flattened out inside the eighth pole. PULPIT'S JET showed good speed from the gate, moved out to race in the three path entering the first turn, headed by the winner going to the half, battled to the far turn racing inside of that rival, had enough and gave way mid stretch. CLASSIC D. D. offered little racing mid track in the second flight. CODE SENDER lagged far off the pace, never involved.
