**Footnotes**

HONEST EXPECTATION stalked a pair of duelers to the quarter pole saving ground, angled out to the three path entering the stretch, drew even with TETON STAR in upper stretch, slowly edged away under strong handling, won drawing off late. TETON STAR broke sharply but was soon headed by PURE RUSH from his inside, dueled to the quarter pole, put that rival away then was challenged by HONEST EXPECTATION top of the lane, dug in matching strides to mid stretch, yielded stubbornly while gamely proving to be second best. PURE RUSH rushed hard along the rail to battle with TETON STAR going down the backside, dueled to the three sixteenths, tired inside the eighth pole and just saved third place being fully extended. IM GOOD AT THAT tracked a contested pace running four wide to the far turn, set down mid turn, needed more in the drive and was edged out of third place in a hard effort. LIL SKELETOL settled in the second flight, advanced mid turn, angled out under a drive upper stretch, mildly bid but never threatened. RIDIN' HARD lacked speed racing mid track, swung widest coming seven to eight wide top of the stretch, improved placing late never menacing. FULL HORSE POWER raced in mid pack, came five wide into the lane giving chase, lacked rally and tired in the drive. GO R V GO lacked speed traveling mid pack, asked for more from the quarter pole, failed to factor. SLIVER was quickly outrun racing wide down the backside, offered little. BUGGS PRIDE made a steady retreat around the bend, no factor.
