FLIP FLOP sent hard from the gate, cleared going into the far turn, increased margin traveling in the three path for the stretch run, won comfortably under steady handling. HE'S A DIXIE BOY settled early, rallied four wide at the quarter pole chasing the winner, failed to menace in the lane and just held on saving second place. MAMA'S WONDER BOY rated early, hit stride leaving the quarter pole, came six wide entering the stretch, closed willingly to just miss second place. MEGONE settled towards the rear, angled to mid track around the bend, launched rally swinging seven wide upper stretch, gained with interest in deep stretch missing a minor award. MORE HUMOR lacked speed and raced along the rail to top of the lane, rallied mid stretch vying for a minor placing but leveled off being outfinished late. OCEAN OF DREAMS rated early racing along the rail, angled out four wide under a drive top of the lane, lacked needed kick. IT'S GOTTA BE US held a good tracking position to the quarter pole, began to chase into the lane, lacked response and tired in the drive. EXCHANGE NOTE pressed the winner to mid turn, started to drop off entering the stretch, no late factor. FIDDLERS JINGO flashed good early foot, was all done top of the lane, used up. UNBRIDLED'S GHOST was quickly outrun, struggled throughout in a dull effort, vanned off.
