Footnotes

WISH UPON THE MOON prompted the pace three deep through the turn, extended at mid track from the eighth pole would rally up late. QUAKER SHAKER TONY sent hard pressured the pace from between horses to upper stretch, dueling in close quarters alongside BLUE MAN TOO would cede to outside pressure. BLUE MAN TOO hustled on lead battled through the turn into upper stretch, kept in close quarters by QUAKER SHAKER TONY would give all to the end. SCREEN TO SCREEN stalked the pace through the turn, dropped off the front trio upper stretch holding position in the six path. PLAYBOY AT HOME off slowly trailed through the turn coming six then eight wide down the lane. HOT APPLE CIDER was never involved traveling six wide through the lane. TOMS LITTLE CAT dropped off at mid track. KITE RUNNER offered little finishing along the rail. ONE FINE ENDEAVOUR flashed early speed then dropped off on the turn coming four wide upper stretch. FLAT RICH folded up on the inside on the turn.
