MOOJI'S EMPIRE sent clear led the way racing in the two path through the turn, widened the margin in upper stretch holding sway to wire. PATENT PENDING slow early angled inside gaining contention in upper stretch, moved from the two path to the three slot late saving place. DYNABOX away slowly was outrun while saving ground through the turn, circled to mid track an eighth out showed some late interest. DUETTINA chased close up through the turn, extending in the four path upper stretch came up short late. FANTASTIC LISA tracked early then dropped off on the turn, taken six wide in upper stretch proved no menace. CATS ZIP gave hard pursuit through the turn into upper stretch weakening late in the three path. MISS MENIFEE was never involved. TRUE JAZZ dropping back early was always outrun. THERES ALWAYS HOPE gave steady retreat finishing near mid track.
