WHITE DIAMOND GIRL slow early circled out on the turn, bid seven wide upper stretch, drew clear driving. FAIR CHASE tracked evenly early, pressed up on the turn, bid gamely five and six wide salvaging place. KINSEY'S GAL slow early was angled inside to upper stretch, bid willingly in the two path late. FLAME BURNS HIGHER chased and pressed through the turn, extended in the six path upper stretch, weakened late. IN THE MONEY broke sharply, worked a short lead through the turn then wore down upper stretch. JUSTIN A STORM pressed then chased on the turn, faded in the three path late. VANA B hustled outside, wavered on the turn giving way to upper stretch. SEW SLIPPERY reared up at the break, labored after. COLOUR HER GOLD was always outrun. PREMIUM CUT struggled throughout.
