BEARCAT KENYON off slowly, trailed the field through the turn, angled out inside the eighth pole, found stride on the outside of rivals, surged up in the final yards. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION hustled close up, pursued hard through the turn, took a late lead, gave more under late pressure, run down in the last strides. ALWAYS TAKE CASH went evenly at mid pack, roused to bid on the turn, loomed into the stretch, lacked punch finishing a weary third. RUNNING ROONEY away slowly, labored racing wide throughout, gave a surge after the fact. CASTLE HILL sent hard, pressed dueling along the inside through the turn, extended battling into the stretch, shortened stride wearing down late. BEST OF HONOR hustled along, lost ground into the stretch, had little left late. FIVE STAR AWARD was always outrun. HENNESSY'S BEST ducked out at the break, hustled wide into the turn, folded up inside the quarter pole giving way. DOUBLE GRACE broke sharply, set the early pace, hooked by CASTLE HILL on the turn, wore out giving way to the stretch.
