DOUGH RE MI prompted to turn, dueled to mid stretch, shook off challenger at 1/8 pole, found more, kicked clear. HEATHER'S DEAL sat behind early pace, moved 3 wide on turn, bid game, turned back at 1/8 pole, no match, held well for place. THE ICE KIDDER pressed at rail, battled through turn, wore down inside, labored to wire. B. L.'S DIXIE slow early, angled lane, passed tiring rivals. MICROSCOPE stumbled start, well back, rushed to turn, leveled off. MIKEYS DANCER even off pace, flattened out. SEE PLURAL outrun to turn, put away.
