Footnotes

FANCYS BEST CHANCE went to the front and set a well rated pace, started to increase margin coming to the quarter pole, held comfortable advantage throughout the stretch under steady encouragement. CURIE rated and raced mid track in the second flight, rallied from mid turn, came six wide into the lane, finished willingly gaining second place. LADY OF THE CAPE lagged far off the pace, labored to the far turn, urged coming to the three eighths pole, past rivals entering the stretch, angled out to the five path splitting foes at the eighth pole, finished with interest but never threatened the winner. WHERE'S THE SUN well placed early, tracked the winner throughout, lacked needed response when called upon, bested rest. U BELONG TO US pressed the winner to the half, started to lose ground around the second turn, faded from upper stretch. GIFT FOR GEO settled in mid pack, urged leaving the far turn, failed to menace. POETIC MANDATE lacked speed racing towards the rear, failed to factor. BESTINTHEWORLD hustled and showed brief foot, was all done midway on the second turn, gave way in the lane. BABY SIS broke awkwardly and the rider lost his irons, was never involved racing far off the pace. ODAKOTA was hustled leaving the gate, raced up close to the far turn, gave way at the quarter pole and was eased mid stretch.
