JOE SIX PACK was swung off the inside early losing ground while advancing to upper stretch, gave a final push six wide arriving in time. IRISH GENTLEMAN stalked close up through the turn, pressed three deep down the stretch, on even terms late would be out gamed by a wide closing JOE SIX PACK at the wire. DEADLY DEALER broke sharply pressuring the pace wrestling a short lead on the turn, collared between rivals down the stretch held well giving all to the wire. TONY LANTANA was sent hard pressuring the pace through the turn, extended on the inside of rivals down the stretch would cede grudgingly late. SPIRIT TO RUN pinched back at the break mustered a mild response to improve down the stretch. SPICE HOUSE played no factor. FLIP FLOP chased through the turn then dropped off at mid track in upper stretch. CAPITOL PANIC was carried out early by JOE SIX PACK losing ground throughout, offered little down the stretch. LIL PERFECT STORM pursued from the rail wavering at the quarter pole wilting into upper stretch. RED PLAYS ROUGH was always outrun.
