Footnotes

LEDGE'S MONARCHOS settled early, launched rally coming four wide at the quarter pole, dueled with RUNZEN to mid stretch, widened late receiving strong left handed stick. A LITTLE TASTE broke outward, settled in the second flight, roused nearing the quarter pole, came five wide into the lane, closed willingly gaining the place position. RUNZEN broke sharply and quickly gained control, angled towards the rail setting the pace, headed by the winner in upper stretch, fought hard but would prove no match, lost the place position in last jumps, game try. COURBET lacked speed and trailed racing at mid track, angled six wide upper stretch, hit stride and closed strongly too late. SENATOR GOLDSTEIN rushed soon after the start, stalked RUNZEN around the turn, gave chase under a stiff drive entering the stretch, failed to threaten and tired inside the furlong marker. WELL THAT'S EONOUGH lacked speed and saved ground throughout, gained momentum top of the stretch, tried to rally while in close quarters from the eighth pole to the finish line running along the rail, needed more room and never menaced. ONE WOULD THINK well placed early, gave chase from mid turn, lacked response and tired in the lane. THE NATIVE BLAZE stalked along the rail to the quarter pole, angled wide under a drive top of the lane, failed to respond and weakened from upper stretch. POWER GRACE raced evenly running towards the inside around the turn in mid pack, dropped off upper stretch, no factor.
