MORGANESE bobbed at the break, quickly sent up to engage NEVER ENOUGH WYNNS, pressed outside that rival to mid stretch, inched clear late, held being fully extended. LITTLE TRUFFLE well placed, sat patient to mid turn, angled out three wide top of the stretch, threatened to the wire, missed in a game effort. READY TO GOES lacked speed, trailed early, rallied while angling eight wide in upper stretch, closed ground fastest of all at the wire, hard try. NEVER ENOUGH WYNNS set a pressured pace running along the rail, fought hard to the wire, yielded grudgingly. MORE THAN rated early, saved ground, mounted a brief bid in upper stretch, leveled off. SLEWS MOUNTAIN GAL broke outward, rushed to gain a good tracking position, loomed at the quarter pole, flattened out in the stretch run. RUNWIND broke alertly, stalked a contested pace, put to a drive mid turn, had no response, weakened from mid stretch. COUNTRY MAIDEN lost footing at the start, settled in the second flight, rallied to vie at the quarter pole racing five wide, gave way mid stretch. GAMBETTO lacked speed, quickly retreated, never involved.
