SEQUIN sent from the gate, dueled with O'DAPURRDEEBABEE to the quarter pole, shook clear entering the stretch, drew off under energetic handling for a convincing victory. MISSILE IMPOSSIBLE lagged to the quarter pole, angled out seven wide top of the lane, hit stride and closed strongly nearing the wire, game try. RAPID REVOLUTION lacked speed racing towards the rear, angled five wide upper stretch, split foes mid stretch and closed in willing manner. BUEA OAK settled early, rallied between foes mid turn, came four wide chasing the winner in upper stretch, was outfinished in deep stretch vying for minor awards. LUCKY MOJA saved ground around the bend, angled out for room in upper stretch, bid between rivals mid stretch, lacked needed surge. RAGIN GAGIN was forwardly placed in the early going, lost position around the turn, came seven to eight wide in upper stretch, mildly improved but never menaced. PATENT PENDING settled early, rushed a four wide move on the turn, chased the winner from the quarter pole, flattened out mid stretch. GUNNY'S GAL pressed the pace traveling three wide, had nothing left by upper stretch, faded in the drive. CARLY'S TIME lacked speed and raced mid track throughout, failed to factor. O'DAPURRDEEBABEE was hard used dueling with SEQUIN to the three eighths pole, gave way in upper stretch finishing spent.
