Footnotes

HACHI tracked the pace through the turn threatening in the four path upper stretch, bore down abreast the leader extending up late. SPICY JACK broke alertly pressing the pace through the turn, wrested the lead in upper stretch digging in from the two path ceded to outside pressure late. USKA'S WALL CAT broke sharply pressing to keep a short lead through the turn, dueling on the inside in upper stretch would wear down late. DOING WITHOUT slow early raced evenly to upper stretch, gained late at mid track. ALLEY DANCER slow early lost ground to upper stretch, gained position seven wide. MAXOPICO chased the pace through the turn, extending in upper stretch leveled off late. DO DAT TUNE played no factor. SUNDAY MISSILE was steadied at the seven sixteenths and three sixteenths poles. CONVICT LAKE gave hard pursuit through the turn tiring in upper stretch. KID KLARE was always outrun.
