**Footnotes**

WACO RUE raced evenly at mid pack traveling four wide to the far turn, hit stride under prompting near the quarter pole advancing steadily to collar RAYWICK outside the eighth pole, edged clear at mid track under stiff urging. SAUCY VINNY unhurried off the early pace responded with a mild move on the far turn, swung six wide in upper stretch came on belatedly chasing WACO RUE to the wire. MANDY'S MAN sent up early following a soft pace to the half, drew even alongside rivals bidding boldly into upper stretch, overpowered from the outside came up short late on the inside. RAYWICK crowded leaving the gate was taken in hand waiting for room, rushed up into the backside joining GILES on pace, worked under pressure coming between horses with a head in front near the three sixteenths pole, collared by WACO RUE in upper stretch would wear down on the inside. ALERT DANCER dropped back early, was never involved improving only position late. TESTINGONETWOTHREE unhurried early gave a minor move on the far turn then quickly leveled off. PIPA CALIENTE rushed close up along the inside early, stalked the pace for a half mile before weakening on the far turn. NICE SHOES was always outrun. COOL CRIMINAL was done early. GILES rushed out to grab the early lead, trying to rate was kept honest by RAYWICK finally giving in to the pressure leaving the far turn.
