Footnotes

FAST FASHION set a pressured pace racing a little off the inside, headed from both sides upper stretch, dug in under severe pressure winning in a very determined effort. PHILLY FRENZY stalked the winner early on, almost drew even at the eighth pole, could not get by but held well saving second place. IFPUSHCOMESTOSHOVE was never far off the pace racing along the rail, loomed off of top pair mid stretch, needed a bit more late despite being hard ridden. MONEY TO BURN well placed racing towards the inside, split foes turning for home, loomed to mid stretch, began to tire late being outfinished for a minor award. TABULATE saving ground traveling in the second flight, angled out top of the lane, improved position but was no real threat. VALIANT HUMOR threw head leaving the gate and brushed with MONEY TO BURN in the opening strides, settled in the second flight, swung out seven wide under a stiff drive entering the stretch, lacked needed kick. GRUBBY'S GIFT well placed in the early going, raced wide around the turn, lacked punch in the drive and weakened late. WAY TO OZ varied little racing wide throughout. RAKA raced towards the rear throughout, offering little. NAMESAKE was sluggish leaving the gate, quickly outrun, never involved.
