MARYLOVESTETON broke alertly, set all the pace traveling in the two path, held firm late under steady encouragement. J'S REDBUD SPIRIT settled in the second flight running at mid track, angled six wide into the lane, finished strongly picking up second place late. KING BEE stalked the winner from the start, set down entering the stretch, gave chase to the wire bit lacked needed surge and was outfinished vying for second place. BOLD PHIL unhurried early racing towards the rear, angled out five wide in upper stretch, gave belated action improving position but never menaced. DANA DYNAMO bobbled at the break but quickly recovered, stalked racing three wide around the bend, failed to respond when asked for more and was outfinished fighting for a minor award. MOONSHINE AMOUR trailed to the quarter pole, mildly improved position but was no threat. NOBLE CAVALIER stalked to the far turn racing along the inside, began to weaken in mid stretch, no late threat. TINKER was hard ridden going into the far turn but lacked response, dropped off to trail entering the stretch, offered little.
