KIM'S WAY veered out steady at the break, circled out leaving the turn, responded at mid track surging quickly to sweep clear late. FIREINYOURNEWSHOES stalked the pace pressing from the turn to wrest the lead in upper stretch, digging in from the three then four path would cede to wide pressure. RUBY'S SILKS stalked the pace pressing up to challenge on the turn, dueling in the four path in upper stretch would weaken late. MY SISTER CONNIE slow early came five wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. MY MOULIN ROUGE was never involved. JENIIGOTYOURNUMBER sent hard worked the pace keeping a short lead through the turn, gave way to pressure in upper stretch. MUNTER AUFGEWACHT away alertly pressed early then retreated on the turn. BONSAI away slowly offered little.
