WATCH TOWER well handled tracking the leader to top of the lane, came three wide under strong handling in upper stretch, edged clear late and prevailed under a stiff drive. BILLY'S DILLYBAR settled in the second flight saving ground, swung out to the four path mid stretch, surged nearing the wire missing in a good effort. LITTLE SKEET broke alertly gaining control, set the pace racing along the inside, headed inside the eighth pole, fought hard to deep stretch, shortened stride nearing the wire. LIVINGSTON'S GHOST forwardly placed from the start, raced inside throughout, angled out abruptly in deep stretch to avoid a tiring LITTLE SKEET just missing the show position. ABSOLUTE RETURN raced mid track around the turn, hard ridden running four wide upper stretch, lacked needed rally. FULLO SUCCESS was sluggish in the early stages, found belated stride improving placing too late, never menaced. ROUNDUP MOMENT settled in the second flight, swung six wide under a drive entering the stretch, failed to respond. HOLY HIGH VIKING stalked to the quarter pole, drifted out to the four path upper stretch giving way, used up. WILD GOOSE CREEK broke outward and raced wide throughout, offered little.
