COUNT ON MY WORD well rated, saved ground throughout, asked mid turn, came through along the rail entering the stretch, vied in a four way duel mid stretch, drew clear late under strong handling. IT'S TIME TO SMILE rated early, sat patient to mid turn, came five wide top of the lane, drew even mid stretch, was outfinished late for the win, proved a willing second best. GO NOW rated while traveling four wide down the backside, bid between foes into the lane, drew even mid stretch, was under a stiff drive to the wire, was out gamed late. CLEVER YANKEE raced up close from the start, bid at the quarter pole racing four wide, took a slight lead upper stretch, fought hard while between foes to deep stretch, came up a little short late. RECOGNITION stalked while in hand, rushed bid to take a slight lead along the inside at the half, dueled on the turn and to mid stretch, ceded late, hard effort. EBBEN ESTOORA raced evenly and off the rail in the second flight, put to a drive mid turn, failed to respond, never menaced. MR EASY E lacked speed, trailed to mid turn, beat two weary foes, never factored. BLAZING ELEMENT pressed while three wide and between foes to the half, began to tire near the quarter pole, had nothing left by top of the stretch. REVOLVER SIX set the early pace, headed near the half mile marker, was all done by the three eighths pole, gave way.
