**Footnotes**

MARCH TREND stalked the pace through the turn moving past a tiring FLEET ACE to grab the lead in upper stretch, responded along the inside from the eighth pole holding safe to wire. EVAN'S EMERALD shied from a veering T QUE at the break, well back advanced six wide out of the turn, moving on MARCH TREND late would run out of ground. MR. FLAMBOYANT raced evenly racing five deep through the turn, gave steady response down the stretch closing in late at mid track. MORE HUMOR tracked evenly through the turn, vied along the inside in upper stretch, gave even late action needing more. T QUE veered out leaving the gate, was rushed along gaining into upper stretch, threatening late lacked punch. THE FLY'N'JACAMACOO slow early was taken seven wide in upper stretch gaining belatedly. CLONEN played no factor. FLEET ACE broke sharply moving clear on pace through the turn, shortened stride in upper stretch giving way abruptly. AMELIAISLANDMISSLE was always outrun. SAVE N TIME labored throughout.
