Footnotes

PARTY LANG was patiently ridden to the far turn, launched rally coming five wide into the lane, drew even a sixteenth out, drew clear late under strong encouragement. ON TOUR tracked a contested pace traveling four wide, bid four wide top of the lane, vied mid stretch running between foes, led briefly in deep stretch but was overpowered by the winner nearing the wire, game effort. LIVER rated early on, settled in the second flight racing wide to the half, rallied mid turn and took the lead leaving the quarter pole, dug in from upper stretch, could not hold on inside the eighth pole, settled for third best in a willing effort. CANDID IMAGE showed good early foot, set a pressured pace racing towards the inside, fought hard vying around the turn, yielded grudgingly in the lane, hard try. ARCH'S ARROW hustled early, moved off the rail entering the backstretch, set a solid pace racing two to three wide, battled to mid stretch, weakened late racing along the rail from mid stretch. SPIRITWOOD unhurried from the gate and angled towards the inside, urged mid turn, angled out six wide top of the stretch, improved placing but never threatened. JET FLAG settled in mid pack running off the rail, roused leaving the far turn, failed to respond, no threat. WORKING MAN BLUES pressured the early pace traveling three to four wide to the half, had enough coming to the quarter pole, weakened in the lane. JULISKA raced along the inside in the second flight, faded near the three eighths pole, no factor.
