SMART AND PRETTY slow early circled out to upper stretch surging abreast rivals near mid track getting up in the final strides. PATTON'S STAR tracked evenly through the turn, gained to threaten from the four path upper stretch, angled in to the three slot bidding gamely late. WHATHEMATTERHEART a step slow through the turn angled inside to upper stretch firing along the rail pressing to the wire. TOORALLOORACOLLORA slow early cut the corner to contention in upper stretch then hung late near the rail. ULTIMATE BLISS sent clear set the pace through the turn, extended between horses in the three and two path would weaken late. LIZGATOGO gave hard pursuit through the turn, wavered inside the eighth pole fading gradually in the three path. WAKKI GOLD hopped then was bumped at the break, played no factor. IT MUST BE LOVE chased early then gave way on the turn. ONE SWEET THING laboring well back was eased the final sixteenth.
