PEGGE'S TREASURES was patiently ridden traveling mid track, roused from the quarter pole, swung four wide into the stretch, headed KID ROCKETTE in mid stretch, matched strides to deep stretch then slowly edged clear under aggressive urging. KID ROCKETTE broke well stalking the leader, vied turning for home, went clear in upper stretch but was soon headed by the winner, went head to head to the wire, was outgamed in last jumps and settled for second best in a solid performance. GIVEN THE GLORY set the pace racing in hand running in the two path, dueled leaving the quarter pole, fought willingly to mid stretch, tired in deep stretch saving third place under urging. JOE'S RISING STAR tracked early on racing along the rail, loomed briefly nearing the quarter pole, leveled off in upper stretch besting rest. ROSIE'S PRAYER raced evenly at mid track, roused to no avail, tired in the drive never threatening. TOUGH SOUP lacked speed running towards the rear throughout, showed little. PRESSTHEHARDWAYS was always outrun, never involved.
