BASEBALLBABESNBEER stalked down the backside, moved up three wide heading LAGOON OF DIAMONDS mid turn, drew even leaving the quarter pole, went head to head to deep stretch then slowly edged away late under strong urging. LAGOON OF DIAMONDS rushed from the gate to gain the lead, pressured around the turn by BASEBALLBABESNBEER, matched strides to deep stretch, yielded grudgingly while proving to be easily second best. DURAND PARK pressed the runner up going down the backstretch, could not keep pace past the quarter pole, did hold well in the late to settle for the show position. NOT ANY PRICE lacked speed and saved ground throughout, found belated stride mid stretch, finished with interest but was no threat. FIONN MAC CUMHAILL trailed early racing towards the inside, angled out six wide mid stretch gaining momentum, improved position but was no menace. AMAZING BUBBA broke outward brushing TEN MARTINIS at the break, rushed up to track the pace traveling off the rail, began to tire entering the stretch, no factor. TEN MARTINIS brushed leaving the gate, settled in the second flight, failed to respond when roused, no factor. IMITATION OF LIFE raced wide in the second flight, varied little never factoring. GILMER hustled from the gate, chased to mid turn, gave way top of the lane finishing spent. RED BIRD SOLDIER was always outrun, dull effort.
