**Footnotes**

DAKOTA DUNES moved clear going into the first turn, set a well rated pace traveling towards the inside, was unchallenged throughout, roused in upper stretch, responded to hold sway late as the lead was diminishing, won driving. SUMMERLUCKY unhurried from the gate and settled far off the pace, urged from mid turn, quickly gained entering the stretch, took aim on loose leader racing in the four path, closed in on the winner rapidly nearing the wire proving a willing second best. MANDU GENIUS rated early and raced mid track, made a mild five wide bid entering the stretch, chased top pair in the lane, failed to menace and leveled off besting rest. VINTAGE DAVE stalked the winner to the half, began to chase from mid turn, lacked response and faded mid stretch. SILVER MAN CAN raced up close to the far turn, could not keep pace leaving the quarter pole, stopped in upper stretch. EASTERMAN raced towards the rear running well off the rail, lost ground around the bend finishing well beaten in a dull effort.
