Footnotes

BAFFIN unhurried through the turn angled five wide upper stretch gaining on a weary front end moving by late. AMERICAN ROMANCE went evenly under hard urging through the turn, bid from the three path upper stretch surging in the closing yards. PRINCESS ADITI chased then pressed putting a head in front three deep on the turn, dueling abreast INSTALL through the lane would cede to outside pressure in the two path. INSTALL broke sharply pressuring the pace through the turn, dueled inside of PRINCESS ADITI upper stretch giving all along the rail coming up a bit short. WONDERBRED sent hard pressured the pace through the turn then faded from the rail in upper stretch. BOZENA veered out leaving the gate, was always a step slow. TIZ NEXT flashed early speed then wilted abruptly on the turn.
