CASANOVA GIANT broke sharply and angled towards the inside, set all the pace while never being seriously threatened, held form late under steady encouragement. STAR NORTH hustled early, stalked the winner throughout, came three wide under a stiff drive upper stretch, needed a bit more late holding on to second place in a willing effort. FOREX TRADER stalked early racing a little off the rail, gave chase entering the stretch, won the battle vying for third place, game try. BEYOND THE OCEAN moved over to the rail shortly after the start, rallied past the quarter pole, battled for a minor award from mid stretch, was outfinished late missing third place. SUMMER MEDALLIST settled in mid pack running towards the inside, failed to respond when roused and tired in the lane. HOPEFUL BANDIT lacked speed and raced mid track throughout, failed to factor. LANDED SAFELY was always outrun, offered little. DILIGENT DEALER was a step slow into stride, then was in tight steadying briefly shortly after the start, rushed a five wide move on the bend to race in mid pack, folded up turning for home finishing spent.
