SO BUSTED sent clear set a soft pace digging in to pressure on the far turn, kicked clear inside the three sixteenths pole dropping to the rail holding firm to wire. HONOR EVENING rated along the inside was roused to contention on the far turn, chased SO BUSTED into upper stretch finishing well in the two path saving place. SPANTASTIC tracked evenly through the backside, took up the chase on the far turn cutting the corner to upper stretch vying gamely along the rail. CIRCUIT STAR stalked the pace moving up to threaten on the far turn, extending in the three path would level off in upper stretch. BOOYA SKEE DADDY unhurried early gained as the field bunched up on the far turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch would drop from contention finishing evenly. TRACK RECORD raced evenly on the backside, drew closer on the far turn then flattened in the three path upper stretch. KID'S PRIZE tracked the pace through the backside, pursued on the far turn then wore out at mid track in upper stretch. KOKOMO GYPSY was always outrun being put away in upper stretch.
