RAMBLIN MIKE was patiently ridden tracking a contested pace, moved quickly on the bend racing in hand, drew off entering the stretch, won easily as much the best. WEEKEND PASS rated early and raced towards the inside, split foes mid turn, chased an easy winner from top of the lane, never threatened while besting rest. ROUNDUP JADE raced four wide entering the first turn, remained off the rail throughout, lacked needed rally while holding off others. SHIVE'S SUCCESS unhurried and lagged far off the pace, asked mid turn, swung six wide entering the stretch, improved placing but failed to factor. KAUFMAN hustled early stalking to the far turn racing in the three path, gave way at the quarter pole. WYO BANDITO dueled for the lead to the half, was all done turning for home, finished spent. LITE UP THE STAGE was hard used going into the first turn, set a pressured pace to the half, was all done near the quarter pole, used up. WILLIE BAGS hustled from the gate and was caught out five wide entering the first turn, raced wide throughout, dropped off midway on the second turn, dull effort.
