Footnotes

FUHRBEE settled nicely running mid pack, advanced mid turn traveling towards the inside, angled out five wide in upper stretch, surged late on a pair of duelers and blew by to win going away. OLGA'S MARBLES showed good speed pressing for the lead, angled outside of YES IMATIGER in upper stretch and vied inside the eighth pole, proved no match for the winner but got second place in last jump, hard effort. YES IMATIGER was hustled leaving the gate, set a pressured pace early on, edged clear past the quarter pole and angled to the rail top of the lane, received severe left handed stick in the lane, was run down late and then failed to hold on to second place being out nodded in last stride. ENGLISH TEACHER tracked the pace and moved out to travel mid track at the three eighths pole, came four wide chasing the leader entering the stretch, finished willingly but needed more late. STONE QUEEN lacked speed racing far off the pace, hit stride entering the stretch swinging six wide, improved placing but was no real threat. INDY LIMELIGHT rushed early, pressed for command and then almost drew even at the quarter pole running along the rail, started to fade near the eighth pole, no late factor. SOUTHERN LULLABY settled in the second flight running wide down the backside, failed to respond when asked, no factor. KELLY'S NO ANGEL was forwardly placed, raced in good stalking position to the quarter pole, had nothing left by upper stretch giving way. LITTLE MISS BUNNY was always outrun, never factored. LIVELY KITTEN was quickly outrun and struggled soon after the start, lost contact with the field.
