Footnotes

MOUNTAIN A. P. broke well and held a slight early advantage running along the inside, left the field behind leaving the quarter pole, widened in the lane under steady handling to the wire. ROMAS SPIRIT well placed from the start racing along the inside, angled out to the four path top of the lane chasing the winning, never menaced but finished in a willing manner holding on to second place. CHEROKEE JOHN lacked speed racing towards the rear, came five wide upper stretch, hit stride late and gave a belated surge improving placing. SKIP FOR GIN was a bit sluggish in the early going, rallied splitting rivals in upper stretch, moved back the rail inside the eighth pole, finished strongly giving best too late. YARDEE showed good early foot, stalked then chased the winner to upper stretch, weakened at the eighth pole. SIR DUR varied little racing in mid pack throughout, lacked response when roused. VANHOOSE flashed good early speed pressing the winner briefly, began to give way past the quarter pole, used up. WHYS BEST GUY raced wide throughout in the second flight, no factor. CHIPPED offered little racing mid track throughout. KEY TO WINNING raced briefly in mid pack, dropped off entering the stretch finishing well beaten.
