WINLOC'S GRAMIE slow early, advanced along rail, drew even mid lane, up gamely. LIES BE GONE chased early pace, closed in near 1/4 pole, took lead, ceded. DIALING DELEMA rushed up early, pressed pace, chased to lane, lacked late move. SAMEE BRASS sent inside, pressed slim lead, drifted wide lane, weakened. LEAR SKYWALKER slow early, rushed on turn, chased to lane, weakened. JETTIN JOSEPHINE slow early, no factor. CRAFTY CONVEYOR away alertly, pressed pace, extended on turn, wore out. BONNIE PANCHO step slow, labored. PRINCESS EL brief foot, retreated. BLUSHING CALLER flashed speed, folded.
