Footnotes

HE'S A CRIMINAL away well stalked BLACKIE NORTON engaging rival on the turn bidding clear into upper stretch, kept to task would draw off convincingly. GRUBBY'S GIFT went evenly giving a mild rally in drive to grab BLACKIE NORTON on the wire for place. BLACKIE NORTON broke sharply to the early lead, collared by HE'S A CRIMINAL on the turn proved no match ceding into upper stretch, gradually wore down the final sixteenth. FLEET ARROW outrun early would swing out to lane finishing widest while remaining no menace. RED RAIDER bore out jamming BRYAN JAMES at the break, was always a step slow. LOOPY LENNY bumped in close quarters at the break was never involved racing greenly through the lane. CHEYCONS REVENGE offered little. BRYAN JAMES was jammed having to steady hard after leaving the gate, would labor far back.
