Footnotes

CHIEF INSPECTOR well handled tracking the pace traveling off the rail to the far turn, bid mid turn running between foes, angled to the rail entering the stretch, vied in a three way duel in upper stretch, gained a slight edge in mid stretch, held safe late under a drive to the wire. ROMA'S WORLD was never far off the pace racing mid track, bid three wide coming to the quarter pole, vied in a three way battle in upper stretch, drew even with the winner in deep stretch, was denied coming to the wire finishing a willing second. DREAMED DAY set a rated pace running in the two path, headed from both sides top of the lane, dueled to mid stretch, weakened proving no match for top pair while digging deep saving third place. HAIL TO THE CHIEF settled in mid pack, bid four wide mid turn, was under a stiff drive in the lane but lacked needed surge besting rest. LIL SKELETOL raced well off the rail in the second flight early on, mildly responded to pressure but failed to threaten. BLUE SOLDIER lacked sped racing five wide down the backside, angled to the rail entering the stretch, showed some late interest slightly improving placing but never factored. BUGGS PRIDE raced up close to the half traveling three wide, was all done leaving the quarter pole and faded throughout the stretch. SO BUSTED pressed the leader to the half racing along the rail, gave way top of the stretch, used up. SICCARDI outrun, never involved.
