SENOR PELIGROSO moved on pace wresting a short lead on the far turn, began to move out in upper stretch winning well clear in the three path. THANKLESS raced evenly while never far back, emerged off SENOR PELIGROSO in upper stretch proving willing in the four path though no match. RIVER CARD hustled out prompted the pace pressing through the far turn, ceded in upper stretch drifting out to the seven path finishing evenly. COOL THUNDER turned head breaking late, stayed back through the far turn circling to mid track in upper stretch, used modest response to improve position. VEGGIE SOUP went evenly saving ground in pursuit to upper stretch, tired late along the rail. ENLIGHTENED TRUTH pressed early then folded up after a half mile. DECISIVE CALL broke alertly prompting the pace through the backside, would wilt abruptly on the far turn. HOME ALARM folded up on the backside.
