CHANG quickly showed in front, set all the pace traveling a little off the rail, asked for more leaving the quarter pole, responded nicely to draw off convincingly, won easily being ridden out. STAINED GLASS stalked the winner from the start, put to a drive near the quarter pole, chased entering the stretch, failed to threaten while holding second place in a willing manner. SLIGO KNOWS tracked down the backside racing along the rail, made a menacing move mid turn was turned away and could not keep pace from upper stretch, leveled off needing more. DAISYIFYOUDO settled in a good tracking position, roused mid turn, gave chase form the quarter pole, lacked punch never threatening. TIP ALONG settled in mid pack, angled to the rail top of the lane under a drive, failed to menace besting rest. WHOS HOT NOW lacked speed racing in the second flight, roused to no avail, offered little. HOB NOBIN lacked speed, raced mid track throughout, never involved. NAE PROBLEM stumbled badly going to knees at the break, was always outrun racing mid track.
