SIGNAL STARLIT unhurried and tucked inside early, prompted to move inside the 3/8 pole, spilt horses on the turn, collared TAKEM AND LEAVUM at the head of the stretch, surged clear near the rail late. VELVETS AND SILKS raced evenly while losing ground to the 1/2, emerged to an extended bid near the 1/4 pole, overmatched by a hard charging SIGNAL STARLIT down the stretch, continued responsive for place. TAKEM AND LEAVEM sent clear into the opening turn, managed to save on a moderate on the inside, maintained margin on last turn, hooked from the inside entering the stretch, was no match but remained willing. AFLEETKITTY laid close up, dropped off of TAKEN AND LEAVUM to the 1/2 mile pole, continued with a steady even stride into the stretch, proved no late menace holding off others. TAP THE SKY tracked the early pace, followed along on the inside for a 1/2 mile, wavered leaving the backstretch, was no late factor. GREE LEE DEE slow in the early going, gave a middle move 5 wide to gain contention near the 1/2, wavered under asking into last turn, dropped back there. FUHR ELISE was always outrun. Z CUTE ONE TWO used to chase the early pace, pursued for a 1/2 mile then folded up.
