Footnotes

EXCHANGE NOTE broke alertly moving past rivals to clear on the turn, moved off in upper stretch being ridden out in the three path. SPREAD THE NEWS stalked early then dropped off on the turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch coming on as a clear second best. BAIRDS VILLAGE slow early raced three path to upper stretch dropping to the rail an eighth out finishing well. PRESSOR slow early saved ground gaining a bit into upper stretch finishing evenly in the two path. A BRIDLED TIGER hustled in pursuit raced four path through the turn then weakened when extended at mid track in upper stretch. WHITEHOUSE RIDGE broke sharply pressing early between horses, chased through the turn then gave way in the four path upper stretch. MATTY'S SONG a step slow early would fold up on the turn. END OF THE GULCH breaking slowly was always outrun. LATENIGHTOFFICER sent hard pressed early along the inside then wilted on the turn.
