Footnotes

LUCKY LESLIE broke alertly moving on pace racing abreast GUILDING REWARD to upper stretch, bearing down on rival to the end needed all to prevail. GUIDED REWARD sent hard pressured the pace along the inside through the turn, dueling near the rail the final eighth would battle to the end. PATENT PENDING tracked evenly while saving ground to upper stretch, angled to the three path made no headway on the leaders while holding the others well safe. VALARI chased early pressing up to challenge on the turn, wavered in the four path upper stretch dropping from contention. ROYAL VESSEL raced evenly in mid pack lacking surge down the lane holding position at mid track. HOLD ME MOLLY slow early played no factor racing six wide through the lane. CHA CHA FOR NOW was always a step slow. TILLIE THE HUNN was always outrun. SPIRITUAL TUNE showed little. THIS CATS ON FIRE pressed early then weakened on the turn giving way to upper stretch.
